Nepal charity fund-raising update

At the end of March Marie-Louise Stewart, Principal Orthodontist at The Orthodontic Practice, visited Nepal as part of a charity trip to help 3 schools in Kathmandu. Marie-Louise was part of a medical team that screened children for health and dental problems.

Prior to the trip, Mansfield Orthodontic Practice donated the proceeds from sales of toothbrushes and other sundry sales over a 2 months period. Patients and staff were also invited to donate and donations were also received from two of our suppliers TOC and DB Orthodontics.

We are very pleased to announce that £1,480 was raised and donated to the Birkdale School Nepal Charity, so that tooth brushes and other supplies could be taken out to Nepal. *“During the trip we were able to screen 357 children for dental health problems,”* Marie-Louise said. *“There is no national health service in Nepal, and they have so very little.
